*Membership fee Associate Member: €500 per year.*

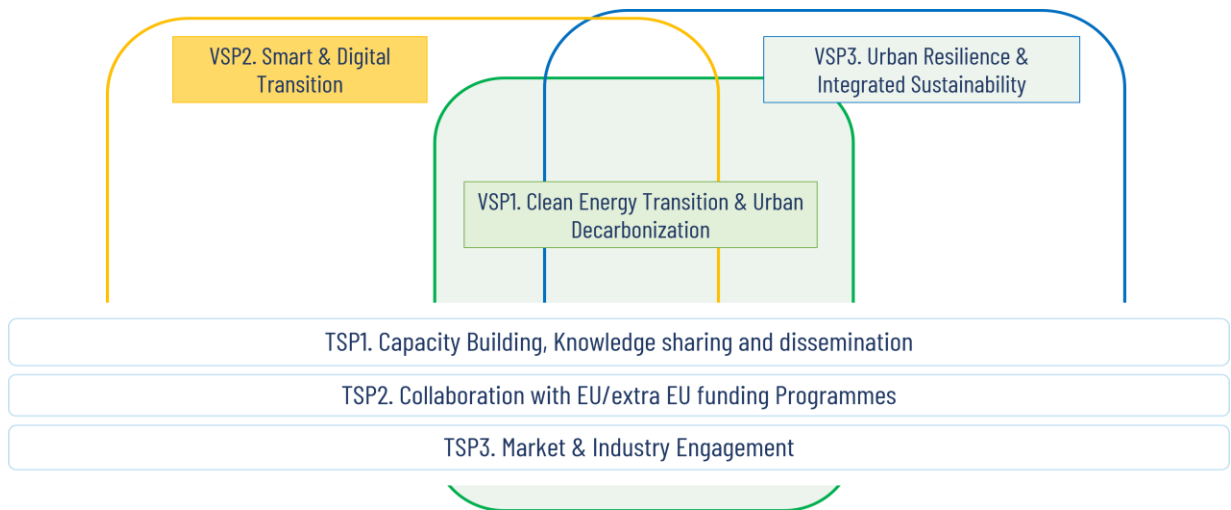
